If you are not immunocompromised, and you received two doses of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine 6 months ago, you may be eligible for a COVID-19 booster shot. Stay tuned for more information regarding Moderna and J&J COVID-19 boosters.

*Immunocompromised = an individual with a weakened immune system due to certain health conditions.

Boosters are currently only available for 18+ year-olds. Boosters have not yet been approved for those who received the Moderna or J&J vaccine, due to a lack of sufficient data. If you received the Moderna or J&J vaccine, stay tuned for further information on booster approval.

*For example healthcare workers, teachers and others whose job puts them at risk of severe COVID-19
