A Message from the NJDOH Health Commissioner

On December 29th Department of Health Commissioner Judith Persichilli released a letter to the public with information and tips regarding COVID-19 vaccination planning:

3. Inform Phase 1A health care workers to pre-register for COVID-19 vaccination

- During early 2021, New Jersey will launch its statewide vaccine scheduling system, the New Jersey Vaccine Scheduling System (NJVSS), to help all potential Phase 1A vaccine recipients to identify nearby points of dispensing sites (PODs) and schedule an appointment. Upon receiving the follow-up email, please share the NJVSS link with health care workers in your network.

Statement from the Bernards Township Health Department

The distribution and administration of COVID-19 vaccinations using both the Pfizer and Moderna vaccine is at the beginning of operations. Vaccine will be administered firstly to health care and emergency service personnel. Simultaneously the CDC and NJDOH has contracted with Walgreens and CVS corporations to administer COVID-19 vaccinations to all residents and staff in long term care facilities. The distribution and administration of the COVID-19 Vaccine to other personnel and community groups will be done in a sequential manner which is still under 'roll-out'. Vaccine Planning – What We Know So Far

- The Moderna COVID-19
 vaccine is now in New
 Jersey and is being
 incorporated
 vaccine planning as Phase 1A continues
 throughout the state. As more doses are
 received, more individuals will be
 vaccinated in the Phase 1A group.
- Vaccinations at skilled nursing facilities began December 28, 2020. Both residents and staff will be vaccinated on-site by either CVS or Walgreens as part of the federal pharmacy program.
- The NJDOH will add the total number of vaccinated individuals in the COVID-19 Dashboard in the coming weeks.


