

Resources on Myocarditis and Pericarditis Following COVID-19 Vaccination

Since April 2021, cases of myocarditis and pericarditis have been reported in the United States after mRNA COVID-19 vaccination (Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna). CDC is aware of these reports, which are rare given the number of vaccine doses administered.

CDC published Clinical Considerations for myocarditis and pericarditis following COVID-19 vaccination. Additionally, resources for the public have been added to CDC's website that can be a resource for patients. CDC Clinical Considerations and Resources for the Public

CDC and its partners are actively monitoring these reports, by reviewing data and medical records, to learn more about what happened and to see if there is any relationship to the COVID-19



vaccination. CDC continues to recommend COVID-19 vaccination for everyone 12 years of age and older, given the greater risk of COVID-19 illness and related, possibly severe complications.

Tracking COVID-19 Variants

The World Health Organization has been working with partners around the world since January 2020 to identify the SARS-CoV-2 virus and the evolution of its variants. During late 2020, emergent of variants that posed an increased risk to global public health prompted the naming of specific variants of interest (VOI) and variants of concern (VOC). COVID FAQ Corner

Q: I see all these restrictions being lifted and the quarantine time is being shortened. Does this mean that incubation time of COVID-19 has changed?

A: No, the incubation time for COVID-19 has not changed. Case counts and transmission for COVID-19 has dropped nationwide so the CDC and NJDOH have allowed for **quarantine time** to be shortened in some scenarios. 14 days is still the recommended time for quarantining after exposure to COVID-19.

Q: I missed my appointment for my second dose of Moderna (or Pfizer). Do I need to start my vaccine process over again?

A: No. The recommendation is to get your second dose as soon as possible after your missed appointment. Contact <u>a vaccine site</u> <u>directly</u> and let them know you need to make an appointment for your second vaccine, and they will do their best to schedule you as soon as possible.

Q: I had an appointment to get a COVID-19 vaccine, but I tested positive. My friend told me I had to wait 90 days to get my vaccine now. Is that true?

A: No. Many people wait the 90 days because of the natural antibodies that come with becoming ill with COVID-19. You can get your COVID-19 vaccine as soon as you feel well and are out of your 10-day isolation period at home.
