BA.2? XE? Omicron , Other Variants and Subvariant Updates

- **BA.1** Omicron was first identified in Botswana and South Africa in Nov, although some cases have been reported earlier in the Netherlands.
- By late Dec, **BA.1** became the predominant strain in the U.S.
- Early reports from South Africa indicated that most cases were mild, and symptoms were different. Many patients had symptoms like fatigue but no loss of taste or smell.
- Compared to the previous variants, Omicron spread more easily than the original SARS-CoV-2 virus and Delta variant. At this time, **BA.2** has spread even faster than **BA.1**.
- Currently in <u>New Jersey</u>, BA.2 accounts for 89.6% of sampled cases. BA.1.1 makes up 9.5% of cases, and BA.1 (original Omicron) accounts for 0.9% of cases.
- Subvariant XE is a hybrid of Omicron BA.1 (original Omicron) and BA.2. Research is being done to see if XE is more transmissible and how severe the symptoms are.
- YES, according to the <u>WHO</u>, BA.3, BA.4 and BA.5 have been identified around the world.
- What do these subvariants affect? Vaccine efforts. Vaccines have worked to protect against symptomatic disease for BA.1 and BA.2 so it's hoped that they will protect against symptomatic disease for XE. Recovering from COVID-19. New variants and subvariants may escape monoclonal antibody therapies.
